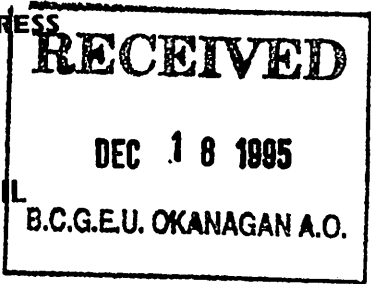

CALL TO ORDER:

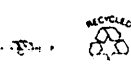
The meeting was called to order by Jeff Fox at 7:30 p.m.
